

ATTACHMENT “C”

VARIANCE REQUEST REQUIREMENTS

If an Employer has the opportunity to secure work that exceeds the limitations contained in the scope or terms of this Agreement, and that could lead to more Employment opportunities for the employees covered by this Agreement, a variance may be requested as outlined.

It shall be the responsibility of the Employer to contact the Chapter Manager to request or inquire about all variances. All variance requests shall be submitted in writing prior to bid date. The Business Manager must grant or deny all such requests for variances and notify the Chapter Manager within 24 hours of receiving such request. It is the responsibility of the Chapter Manager to notify all Employers of such approval or denial. Variance denials may be subject to review by the IBEW 6th District International Vice-President and the NECA Midwestern Region Executive Director. There must be at least one non-signatory electrical bidder on any project for it to qualify for a variance request. Any Employer securing a project without having requested and received an approved variance shall be bound by all terms and conditions of this Agreement.
